

Redbank Track



Location of the Redbank Track

The Redbank Track is situated on the banks of Toongabbie Creek in the area behind the CCA Northmead site. The track was originally an initiative by Council, Westmead Hospital and the Upper Nepean Catchment trust with manpower supplied by the Department of Correctional services Periodic Detention Centre.

In early 2007 CCA partnered with Council to develop plans to complete the Redbank Track. CCA also asked experts Cumberland Ecology to prepare a plan to remediate vegetation in the surrounds of the track. The plan was approved by Council and the NSW Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

Work undertaken to date by CCA includes:

- Improvements to the flow of storm water to Toongabbie Creek
- Removal of camphor laurel trees and re-establishment of local native vegetation
- Regeneration of existing bushland between stormwater outlets restoration works to existing sections of the Redbank Walking Track.

The final stage of the works including continuation of the boardwalk (linking to the existing section behind 102 Briens Road), a footbridge, deck and stairs as well as planting (behind the Warehouse) has commenced and is scheduled for completion prior in early 2009. The boardwalk will be wheelchair accessible.
